

TWO-NEEDLE MITTENS

INFANTS MITTENS No. 5601

Size 6 Months to 1 yr.

1 Pr. Standard No. 3 Needles

Jack Frost Baby Yarn 3 Fold—1 1-oz. Ball

RIGHT MITTEN: Cast on 36 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 15 rows. Work beading on next row as follows: K 1, Y O, K 2 tog.; repeat from * across row. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 2 rows, then work in pattern as follows: **Row 1**—(right side) knit. **Row 2**—* K 1, P 2; repeat from * across row. Repeat above 2 rows until piece measures 2½ in. from ribbing. Decrease tip of mitten as follows: **Row 1**—* K 2 tog., K 1; repeat from * across row. **Row 2**—P 2 tog. across row. **Row 3**—K 2 tog. across row. Draw remaining sts tog. and fasten off. Sew side seam. Draw ribbon through beading as illustrated.

LEFT MITTEN: Work as given for right mitten.

INFANTS MITTENS No. 5602

Size 6 Months to 1 yr.

1 Pr. Standard No. 3 Needles

Jack Frost Baby Yarn 3 Fold—1 1-oz. Ball

RIGHT MITTEN: Cast on 37 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 15 rows. Work beading on next row as follows: * K 1, Y O, K 2 tog.; repeat from * across row. K 1, P 1, for 2 rows, then work in pattern as follows: **Row 1**—Knit, 18, increase 1 st in next st, K 18. **Row 2**—* K 1, P 2; repeat from * 5 times, P next 2 sts for thumb gusset, * P 2, K 1; repeat from * 5 times. **Row 3**—K 18, increase 1 st in each of next 2 sts, K 18. **Row 4**—K 1, P 2, over the first 18 sts, P 4; P 2, K 1, over remaining 18 sts. **Row 5**—K 18, increase 1 st in next st, K 2, increase 1 st in next st, K 18. **Row 6**—K 1, P 2, over the first 18 sts, P 6; P 2, K 1, over remaining 18 sts. **Row 7**—K 18, increase 1 st in next st, K 4, increase 1 st in next st, K 18. **Row 8**—K 1, P 2, over the first 18 sts, P 8; P 2, K 1, over remaining 18 sts. **Row 9**—K 18, increase 1 st in next st, K 6, increase 1 st in next st, K 18. Continue increasing every other row until there are 12 sts in thumb gusset. Divide work for thumb as follows: K 19; place on st-holder. K across next 10 sts for thumb. Place remaining 19 sts on 2nd st-holder. Work back and forth in stockinette st on the 10 thumb sts for 6 rows. Decrease tip of thumb as follows: **Row 1**—P 2 tog. across row. **Row 2**—K 2 tog. twice, K 1. Draw remaining sts tog. and fasten off. Sew thumb seam.

Place sts from first st-holder to Needle. Attach yarn. Place sts from 2nd st-holder to left hand Needle. K the first 2 sts tog. on left hand Needle then K across row. Work even in pattern until piece measures 1¾ in. from base of thumb or desired length. Decrease tip of mitten as follows: **Row 1**—K 1, * K 2 tog., K 1; repeat from * across row. **Row 2**—P 2 tog. across row ending P 1. **Row 3**—K 2 tog. across row ending K 1. Draw remaining sts tog. and fasten off. Sew side seam. Draw ribbon through beading as illustrated.

Work left mitten to correspond.

THUMBLESS MITTENS No. 5603

Size 1 to 2 yrs.

1 Pr. Standard No. 4 Needles

Jack Frost Knitting Worsted—2-oz.

RIGHT MITTEN: Cast on 27 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 12 rows, then work beading on next row as follows: * K 2 tog., Y O (yarn over); repeat from * across row ending K 1. Work in ribbing of P 1, K 1, for 4 rows. Work even in stockinette st for

22 rows (about 2½ in.). Decrease tip of mitten as follows: **Row 1**—K 2, * K 2 tog., K 3; repeat from * across row. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—K 2, * K 2 tog., K 2; repeat from * across row. **Row 4**—Purl. **Row 5**—* K 1, K 2 tog.; repeat from * across row ending K 2. **Row 6**—P 2 tog., across row. Draw remaining sts tog. and fasten off. Sew side seam.

LEFT MITTEN: Work as given for right mitten.

With contrasting color, make a chain st cord of desired length, to draw through beading at wrist and trim with Pompoms as illustrated.

CLASSIC MITTENS No. 5604

Size 1 to 2 yrs.

1 Pr. Standard No. 4 Needles

No. 4 White Crochet Hook

Jack Frost Knitting Worsted—2-oz.

RIGHT MITTEN: Cast on 27 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 12 rows. Work beading for draw-string as follows: * K 2 tog., Y O; repeat from * across row ending K 1. Work in ribbing of P 1, K 1, for 4 rows. K 1, row, P 1 row, then start gusset for thumb on next row as follows: **Row 1**—K 12, increase 1 st in next st, K 1, increase 1 st in next st, K 12. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—K 12, increase 1 st in next st, K 3, increase 1 st in next st, K 12. **Row 4**—Purl. **Row 5**—K 12, increase 1 st in next st, K 5, increase 1 st in next st, K 12. **Row 6**—Purl. **Row 7**—K 12, increase 1 st in next st, K 7, increase 1 st in next st, K 12. **Row 8**—Purl. **Row 9**—K 13; place on st-holder. K 2 tog. K 7; place remaining 13 sts on 2nd st-holder.

Work in stockinette st on the 8 thumb sts for 5 rows, then decrease as follows: **Row 1**—* K 2 tog., K 1; repeat from * once ending K 2 tog. **Row 2**—P 2 tog., P 1, P 2 tog. Draw remaining sts tog. and fasten off. Sew thumb seam.

Place the first 13 sts from first st-holder to Needle, attach yarn, pick up 1 st at base of thumb. Place the sts from 2nd st-holder to left hand Needle and work across row. Work even in stockinette st for 14 rows, then decrease tip of mitten as follows: **Row 1**—K 2, * K 2 tog., K 3; repeat from * across row. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—K 2, * K 2 tog., K 2; repeat from * across row. **Row 4**—Purl. **Row 5**—* K 1, K 2 tog.; repeat from * across row ending K 2. **Row 6**—P 2 tog. across row. Draw remaining sts tog. and fasten off. Sew side seams.

LEFT MITTEN: Work as given for right mitten.

With contrasting color, make a chain st cord of desired length to draw through beading at wrist and trim with Pompoms as illustrated.

CLASSIC MITTENS No. 5605

Size 3 to 4 yrs.

1 Pr. Standard No. 4 Needles

Jack Frost Knitting Worsted—2-oz.

RIGHT MITTEN: Cast on 30 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 2¼ in. K 1 row, P 1 row, then start thumb gusset as follows: K 14, increase 1 st in each of next 2 sts, K 14. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—K 14, increase 1 st in next st, K 2, increase 1 st in next st, K 14. **Row 4**—Purl. **Row 5**—K 14, increase 1 st in next st, K 4, increase 1 st in next st, K 14. **Row 6** Purl. Continue increasing in the above manner having 2 more sts between increases every other row until there are 8 sts between increased sts. P 1 row after last increased row, then work as follows: K 15; place on st-holder. K next 10 sts for thumb. Place remaining 15 sts on 2nd st-holder. Work back and forth in stockinette st for 7 rows. Decrease tip of thumb as follows: **Row 1**—K 2 tog. across row.

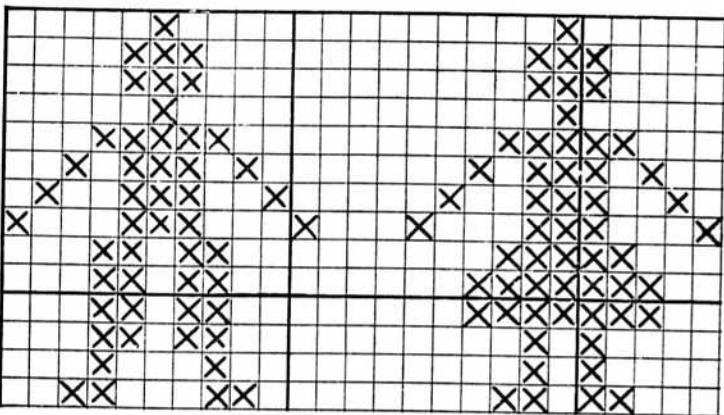
Particular care has been taken to have the instructions in this volume accurate. However, we cannot assume responsibility for human or typographical errors. Always check your scale of stitches before starting a garment.

Row 2—P 2 tog. twice, K 1. Draw all sts tog. and fasten off. Sew thumb seam.

Place the 15 sts from first st-holder to Needle, attach yarn, pick up 2 sts at base of thumb. Place remaining 15 sts from 2nd st-holder to left hand Needle and K across row. Work back and forth in stockinette st for 16 rows. P 1 row decreasing 1 st at each end (30 sts). Starting on right side, decrease tip of mitten as follows: **Row 1**—K 1, K 2 tog., K 9, slip next st, K 1, P S S O (pass slipped st over the K st), K 2, K 2 tog., K 9, slip 1 st, K 1 st, P S S O, K 1. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—K 1, K 2 tog., K 7, slip 1 st, K 1 st, P S S O, K 2, K 2 tog., K 7, slip 1 st, K 1 st, P S S O, K 1. **Row 4**—Purl. **Row 5**—K 1, K 2 tog., K 5, slip 1 st, K 1 st, P S S O, K 2, K 2 tog., K 5, slip 1 st, K 1 st, P S S O, K 1. **Row 6**—Purl.

Weave or sew tip of mitten tog. Sew side seam.

Embroider in cross st as illustrated. See chart.



LEFT MITTEN: Work as given for right mitten.

These mittens may be made in size 6 to 8 by casting on 33 sts for cuff and working in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 2¾ in. then follow instructions as given for No. 5609. For variation see No. 5618 which are made with Ombre Rainbow yarn.

CLASSIC MITTENS No. 5606

Size 4 to 6 yrs.

1 Pr. Standard No. 5 Needles

Jack Frost Knitting Worsted—2-oz.

RIGHT MITTEN: Cast on 30 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 2, as given for No. 5609, until piece measures 2¼ in. from lower edge. K 1 row, decreasing to 29 sts. P 1 row, then start thumb gusset as follows: **Row 1**—K 13, increase 1 st in next st, K 1, increase 1 st in next st, K 13. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—K 13, increase 1 st in next st, K 3, increase 1 st in next st, K 13. **Row 4**—Purl. Continue increasing in the above manner, having 2 more sts between increases every other row until there are 5 increased rows in all. P 1 row after last increased row, then work as follows: K 14; place on st-holder. K next 11 sts (thumb sts). Place remaining 14 sts on 2nd st-holder. Work back and forth on the 11 thumb sts for 8 rows, then decrease tip of thumb as follows: **Row 1**—* P 1, P 2 tog.; repeat from * across row ending P 2. **Row 2**—K 2 tog. across row. Draw remaining sts tog. and fasten off. Sew thumb seam.

Place the 14 sts from st-holder to Needle. Attach yarn and pick up 3 sts at base of thumb. Place remaining 14 sts from 2nd st-holder to left hand Needle and K across row. Work back and forth in stockinette st on the 31 sts until piece measures 2½ in. from base of thumb. Decrease tip of mitten as follows: **Row 1**—K 1, K 2 tog., K 9, slip next st. K 1, P S S O (pass the slipped st over the K st), K 2 tog., K 1, K 2 tog., K 9, slip 1 st, K 1, P S S O, K 1. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—K 1, K 2 tog., K 7, slip 1 st, K 1,

P S S O, K 2, K 2 tog., K 7, slip 1 st, K 1, P S S O, K 1. **Row 4**—Purl. **Row 5**—K 1, K 2 tog., K 5, slip 1 st, K 1, P S S O, K 2, K 2 tog., K 5, slip 1 st, K 1, P S S O, K 1. **Row 6**—Purl. Weave or sew tip of mitten tog. Sew side seam.

LEFT MITTEN: Work as given for right mitten.

Work 1 row of blanket stitching around mitten as illustrated, working from the back of mitten.

For variation these mittens may be styled as given for Nos. 5615 and 5611.

RIBBED MITTENS No. 5607

1 Pr. Standard No. 8 Needles

Size 4 to 6 yrs.

Jack Frost Willow Yarn—1 2-oz. Skein

or

Jack Frost Knitting Worsted—1 4-oz. Skein

RIGHT MITTEN: With Willow Yarn or double strands of Knitting Worsted, cast on 23 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 2½ in. K 1 row decreasing to 20 sts. P 1 row, then start thumb gussets as follows: **Row 1**—K 9, increase 1 st in each of next 2 sts, K 9. **Row 2**—K 10, P 2, K 10. **Row 3**—K 9, increase 1 st in next st, K 2, increase 1 st in next st, K 9. **Row 4**—Purl. **Row 5**—K 9, increase 1 st in next st, K 4, increase 1 st in next st, K 9. **Row 6**—Purl. **Row 7**—K 9, increase 1 st in next st, K 6, increase 1 st in next st, K 9. **Row 8**—K 10; place on st-holder, P 8 (thumb sts), place remaining 10 sts on 2nd st-holder. K 1 row, P 1 row, on the 8 thumb sts for 6 rows, then decrease as follows: **Row 1**—K 2 tog., K 3, K 2 tog., K 1. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—K 2 tog. across row. Draw remaining sts tog., and fasten off. Sew thumb seam.

Place sts from first st-holder to Needle; attach yarn and pick up 2 sts at base of thumb. Place sts from 2nd st-holder to left hand Needle and K them. Work in pattern as follows: * K 1 row, P 1 row, for 5 rows; K 1 row on P side; repeat from * until piece measures 2½ in. from base of thumb (5 ridges), then decrease tip of mitten as follows: **Row 1** (right side)—K 2, * K 2 tog., K 3; repeat from * across row. **Row 2**—Purl. **Row 3**—* K 3, K 2 tog.; repeat from * across row ending K 3. **Row 4**—Purl. **Row 5**—K 1, then K 2 tog. across row. **Row 6**—P 2 tog. across row. Draw remaining sts tog. and fasten off. Sew side seam.

LEFT MITTEN: Work as given for right mitten.

CLASSIC MITTENS No. 5608

Size 4 to 6 — 6 to 8 — 8 to 10 yrs.

1 Pr. Standard No. 8 Needles

Jack Frost Willow Yarn—1 2-oz. Skein

or

Jack Frost Knitting Worsted—1 4-oz. Skein

RIGHT MITTEN: With Willow Yarn or double strands of Knitting Worsted, cast on 22 sts (size 6 to 8, 24 sts—8 to 10, 26 sts). Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 15 rows (size 6 to 8, 17 rows—8 to 10, 20 rows). P 1 row decreasing 2 sts in center of row. K 1 row, P 1 row, then start thumb gusset as follows: K 9, increase 1 st in each of next 2 sts, K 9 (for size 6 to 8, K 10 before and after the increases—for size 8 to 10, K 11 before and after the increases). P 1 row. K 9, increase 1 st in next st, K 2, increase 1 st in next st, K 9. Continue increasing as described above, having 2 more sts between increases every other row with 1 P row in between until there are 6 sts between increases for size 4 to 6 (8 sts for size 6 to 8 and 8 to 10), then work as follows: K 10, place on st-holder; K 8 (thumb sts), place remaining 10 sts on 2nd st-holder [size 6 to 8,
