

Cinnamon Broom Deer

This is great for hanging on your door where a wreath would be too thick. It is quick and simple to make.

Supplies and tools:

Cinnamon broom

Bows, poinsettias, or Holly for embellishments

Use your creative mind here.

Black and white felt for the eyes

Note, the white speck in the eye is a ¼ inch paper punch glued to the felt

Red Plastic Christmas Tree Ball Ornament for nose

Hot Glue gun with glue stick

a couple feet of twine

If you have the long handled broom as in the picture at the bottom right, cut the handle off just below the binding. This is an easy task with the band saw. Separate the broom into two equal parts and tie with twine

Trace eye patterns below onto felt, cut out and hot glue in position. Hot glue the red ball in place.

Hot glue your choice of embellishments to cover the twine. You could also add a little spray snow from a can on the tips of the reindeer “antlers” Add a ribbon to the back Just at the bottom of the separated “antlers” for a hanger.
